As **readers and writers** we will....

- Learn to read and write with the Read Write Inc programme through phonics based activities and books
- Explore traditional Stories based in Forests: Little Red Riding Hood and Goldilocks.
- Make stick puppets to tell the stories, use drama and role play to explore the feelings and emotions of the characters.
- Use nonfiction books to find out about plants and animals.

As **poets** we will....

- Listen to lots of rhyming poetry ,play with rhyming words learn and perform poems and rhymes

As **mathematicians** we will....

- Count and sort objects to 10
- Read and write numbers to 10
- Count backwards from 10
- Count 1 more and 1 less
- Compare and order numbers and objects
- Learn to use the part whole model
- Make and compare number bonds



As **geographers** we will:

- Learn about maps, what they are used for, and make a map of Little Red Riding Hoods Forest.

As **historians** we will....

- Find out about The Great Fire of London of 1666 . Where and when did the fire begin? What happened in the great fire? How did people live in 1666? How do we know what happened?
- We will create paintings, collages, timelines and take part in activities to learn about the Great Fire.

- Find out about trees, plants and forest animals.
- Identify and name some common plants and animals.
- Explore why animals live together in the Forest habitat.

- Explore the tree pictures of artist Gustav Klimt

- Make different forest animals using various materials and different ways of joining and fixing.
- Design own Tudor house choosing materials to create this, thinking about how Tudor houses were built in the past.
