# YEAR 1 HOMEWORK TASKS

## Spring term

- The homework tasks are to link with our topic this half term. They are designed to be enjoyable and meaningful activities that can be done with the support and involvement of other members of your family.
- The tasks in the circle, shown in red must be completed.
- Then choose from the other activities shown in black, you may decide to do one, two or even all of them, it's up to you!
- Complete the red homework every week
- Choose, complete and bring in the other activity homework when you have finished it throughout the half term and holiday. The last date for bringing in homework is 31<sup>st</sup> March

### Make a Farm Shop

You could use toy food or real fruit and vegetables as well as used and cleaned tubs of butter and bottles of milk. Arrange the food so your customers can see what they'd like to buy and make some price tags so they know how much everything is! If possible, use real money including 1, 2, 5 and 10 pence coins.

### Find out where your food is from

Have a look in your cupboard at your tins and packets and try to find out where in the world they have come from.



**Read your school book as usual with an adult.** Read the school book a little every day if you can but at least 4 times a week. Read the same book several times. It is really good practice to read it more than once to build fluency. Change your books on a Monday, Wednesday

or Friday. Change at least 2x a week, 3x is even better.

Enjoy sharing home or library books together too whenever you can.

#### Make a Farm

You might already have a toy farm – if so set it all up and arrange the animals into their fields/stables/sties and take a photo. If you don't have one, see if you can make one using Lego or a cardboard box – anything you like!



### Signs of Spring!

Go on a walk and try to find some signs that Spring has sprung! Can you find some snowdrops or daffodils, baby lambs in fields or birds nesting? Take photos of what you find and share them with us on Dojo. Draw or paint a picture from your walk and bring it into school to go in our Spring Gallery in the Year 1 classroom.
