### Congratulations to this week's Lighthouse Winners

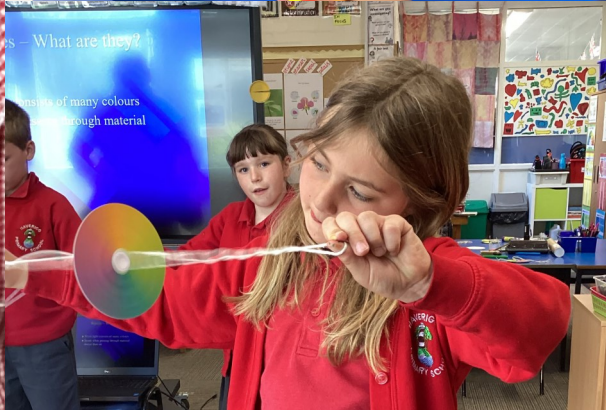
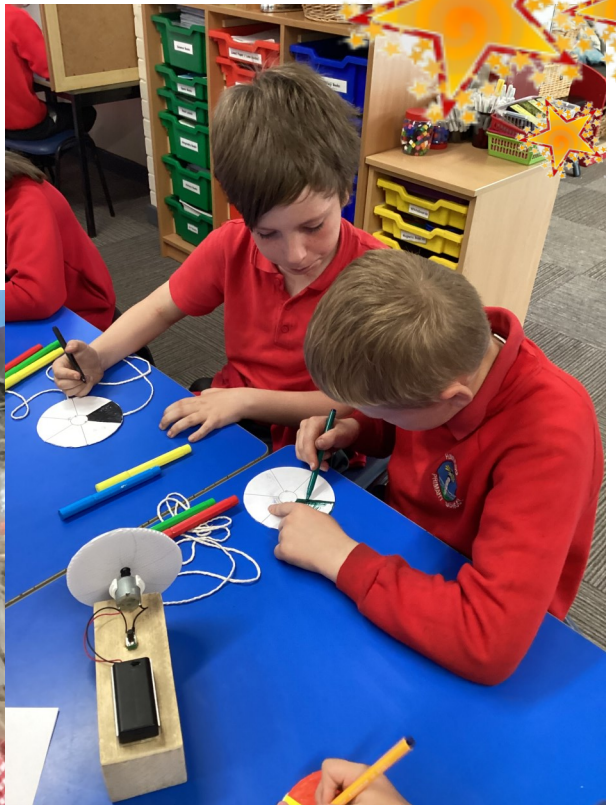
