

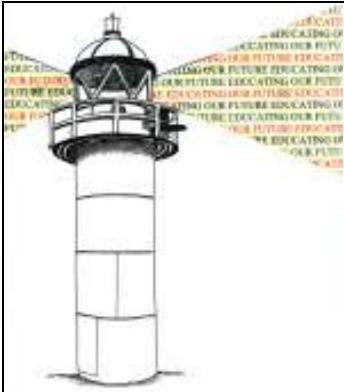

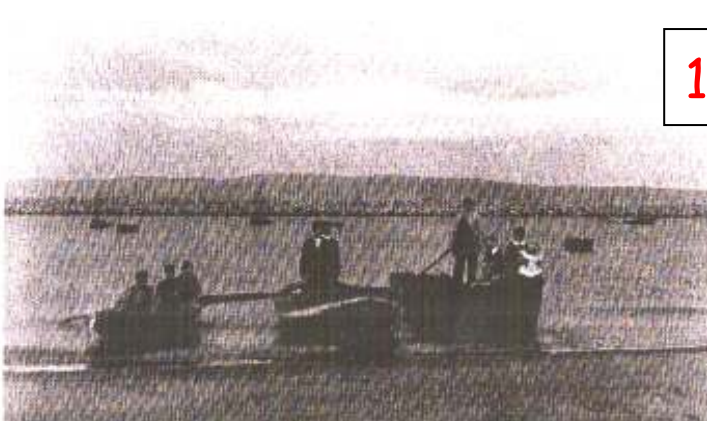
HERITAGE TRAIL 2008

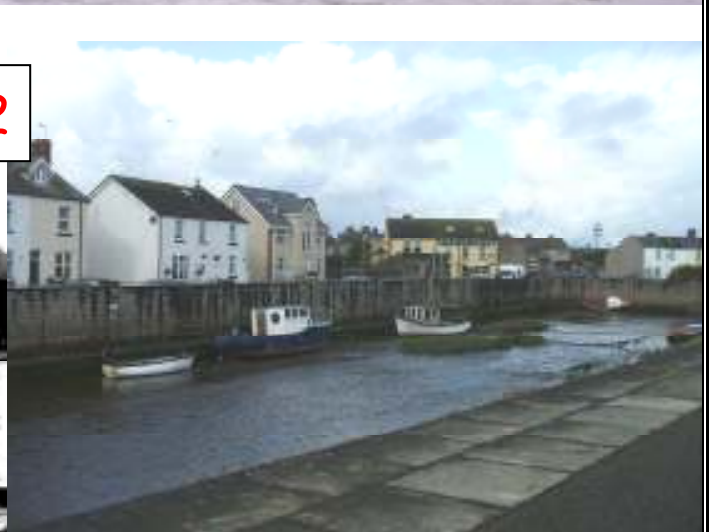
