### Every Day Counts....

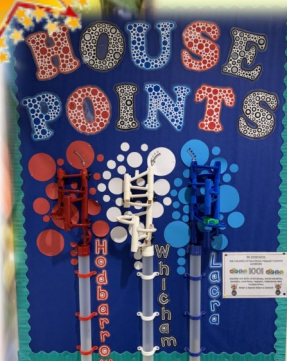

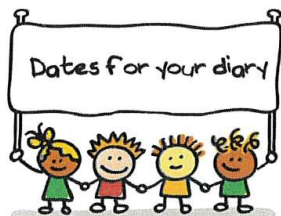
